

Mallorca is the largest island of the balearic archipelago with Ibiza, Minorca and Formentera. The name derives from Latin insula maior, "larger island". It is very well connected with the rest of Europe with its international airport.

The Gran Hotel is a former historic hotel in Palma de Mallorca.

It is part of the historic centre of the city. The hotel was designed by Lluís Domènech i Montaner and completed in 1903.

Today the building has been converted into a cultural center, home to the Fundación la Caixa. It contains a permanent exhibition of paintings by Anglada Camarasa.

The building is one of the most important examples of Modern art on the island, with a facade lavishly decorated with sculptures and ceramics.











The gran hotel also possesses a restaurant (B) with 50 places


Many quick restauration options as bar/tapas and menu around 12 euros are also available (red dots)



42 hotels are within 2 km distance of the conference centers as well as of the metro station of placa d'España.





The conference venue can be accessed by plane. Mallorca airport is Son Sant Joan (airport code PMI) and is located at 12 km from Palma. Most low cost companies fly to Mallorca as for instance Easyjet, Ryanair, Airberlin and Aireuropa.

Besides taxi, from the airport one can take a bus to Plaza España. It is bus No 1. It will continue from there to the ferry terminal, running along the Avenidas, the Paseo Mallorca, Via Argentina and the Paseo Maritimo. It is leaving every 15 minutes. The first bus leave the airport at 6am while the last one is at 1h45 pm <u>bus line 1</u>

Once at Plaza España, there is another information office, to pick up time tables. The information is open daily 9.00 hour to 20.00 hour. Saturday 9.00 hour to 13.30 hour. Sunday and public holidays closed.
