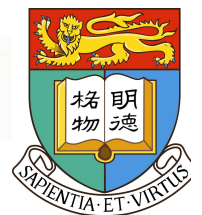


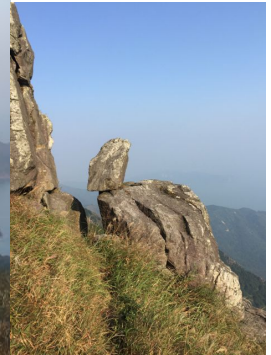

Today HKU has ten faculties. Faculty of Science has 150 professoriate staff, 2715 undergraduate students, and 519 research postgraduate students.

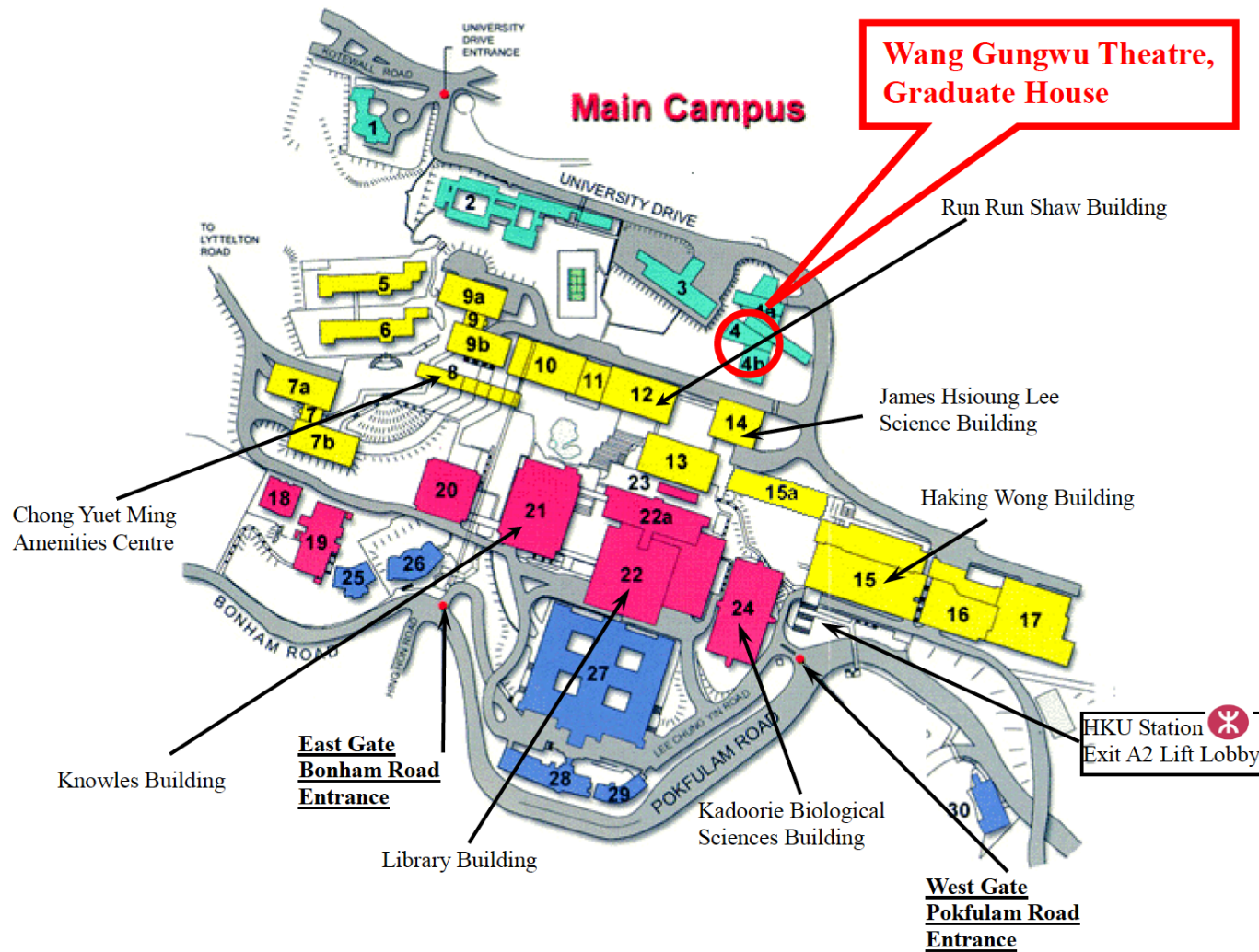
The research in the department of Physics includes following areas:

Astrophysics and Astronomy; Theoretical and Experimental Condensed Matter Physics (with strong research track record in 2D materials); Materials Sciences; Quantum information and computing; Theoretical Atomic Physics and Degenerate Quantum Gases, Experimental Nuclear Physics, and High Energy Particle Physics. It also includes Centre of Theoretical and Computational Physics and it is involved with Laboratory for Space Research.

Transportation to HKU:

1) *By Bus:*

Take either No. 23, 40, 40M from Admiralty outside Pacific Place or either No. 4, 7, 91 from Exchange Square at Central. Alight at the bus-stop in front of the East Gate on Bonham Road or the West Gate in front of Haking Wong Building on Pokfulam Road.

2) *By MTR:*

Get onto the Campus from HKU Station (Exit A2) and take the lift to the Upper Level of University Street.

3) *By Taxi:*

From Admiralty or Central to Cotton Tree Drive to Robinson Road to Kotewall Road. Turn right onto University Drive.

Directions

- Airport to Hong Kong Island
 - Airport Express train from airport to Hong Kong station (last stop) - ~30 min, 100 HK\$
 - Taxi from airport – (~30-50 min, ~300 HK\$)
- Hong Kong station to HKU
 - MTR: go to concourse from Airport express, follow the signs for Blue Island line towards Kennedy Town, take the train and exit at HKU station, exit A2 is HKU campus, ~20 mins
 - Taxi - ~20 mins, ~30-50 HK\$

Taxi fares and times depend on the traffic, MTR trains are fast and reliable.
